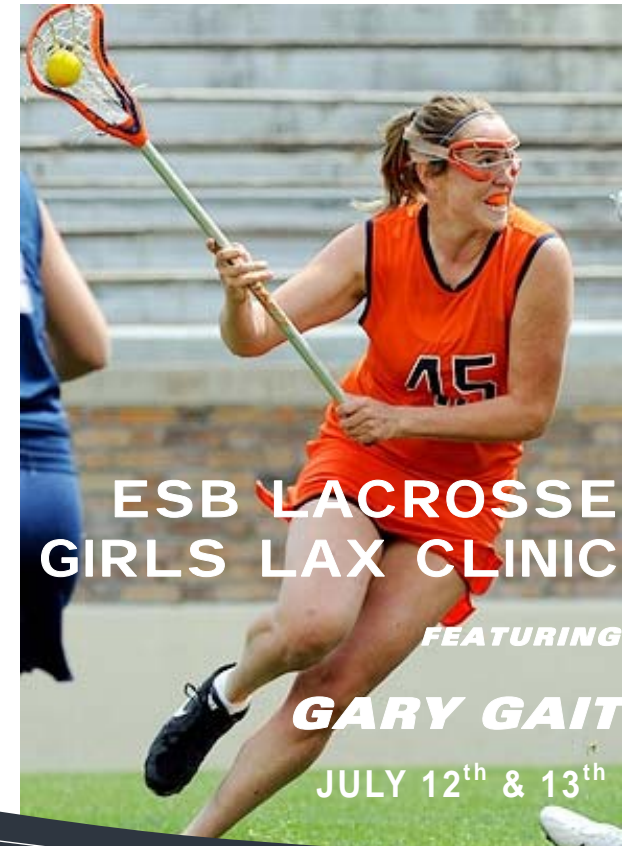
About Gary:

Gait was named the second head coach in the history of the Syracuse women's lacrosse program in August 2007. In his first season at the helm, Gait led the Orange to new heights. Syracuse won its first outright BIG EAST regular-season crown and successfully defended the tournament title.

Gait is a 10-time NCAA champion, having won three titles as a player for the Orange (1988-90) and seven as an assistant women's lacrosse coach at the University of Maryland (1995-01). Widely regarded as one of the best to every play the game.
